**Road Tour** Mr. Bogart distributed a packet to the Council including maps, information of road surface techniques and a more detailed description of the specific road

projects for 2013.

Mr. Bogart stated he would be narrating during the bus tour. He explained the tour would concentrate on various road conditions, storm drainage and road surfacing techniques that would be utilized in the proposed road improvement projects for 2013.

The meeting reconvened from conference room 102 B to the Senior Citizen Center bus. The bus was driven by Mr. Langel. Mr. Forsythe assisted in navigating.

The tour covered various sections of the Township. Mr. Bogart explained techniques likely to be used for this year's improvements, including the use of slurry and chip seals, which if applied as part of the initial program or shortly thereafter increases the lifespan of the roadways.

Mr. Bogart pointed out some areas that had been completed over the past few years to demonstrate the effectiveness of the slurry seal when applied timely.

On motion of Councilman Norgalis seconded of Councilman Pedroso and unanimous vote the meeting was adjourned at 10:45 a.m.
