

**WEGMANS ANNOUNCES VOLUNTARY RECALL OF NECTARINES, PLUMS
AND PEACHES**

Store Bakery Products That Contain Items Also A Concern

Wegmans has announced a voluntary recall of nectarines, plums and peaches that may be contaminated with the bacteria *Listeria monocytogenes*. *Listeria* is an organism which can cause serious and sometimes fatal infections in young children, senior citizens and individuals with weakened immune systems.

The grocer reports that organic and non-organic fruit in multiple varieties and sizes was supplied by Wawona Packaging Company of California. Routine testing by the company showed potential contamination with *Listeria* bacteria. Customers who purchased the recalled products between June 1 and July 20, 2014 should immediately discard them at home and visit the service desk at a Wegmans location and identify the product for a full refund.

The voluntary recall also includes Wegmans bakery products that may contain fresh peaches, nectarines and plums in multiple varieties and sizes. These baked goods may contain fruit also supplied by Wawona Packaging Company. It is recommended these items also be discarded at home with customer return to the store for a full refund.
