PFIZER CORPORATION PRESENTATION: REMEDIATION SITE CLEANUP AT FORMALLY KNOWN AMERICAN CYANAMID PROPERTY

The presentation provided background information on the site, current status, and various action plans that the Environmental Protection Act (EPA) may require of Pfizer. Funding to clean up the site ranged from zero dollars upward to 1.8 billion dollars.

Currently, there are 10 million gallons of oil onsite. Temporary plastic covers would be removed and replaced with permanent caps. 650,000 gallons of ground water are extracted and shipped offsite daily. The objective is to return the property to productive use by year 2020; to provide an active recreation area located in the flood zone, offer public access to the waterfront of the Raritan River Greenway, and create more open space.

Pfizer is looking for public input by sending letters and emails to EPA in support of the presented project to move the plan to the top of the list.
