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BRIDGEWATER TOWNSHIP OFFERS INFLUENZA VACCINATION CLINICS

The Bridgewater Township Division of Health encourages all older adults in the community to receive seasonal influenza vaccinations. Preventive vaccination has been found to play a vital role in the wellness of older adults during the influenza season. The following seasonal influenza clinic dates have been scheduled for Township residents age 60 or older and other “high risk” individuals. These individuals include Township residents with diabetes, asthma, respiratory illness and heart related diseases and ailments.
