# Bridgewater Township Winter Storm Update January 26, 2015

### > Latest Forecast

## **Expected snow totals:**

Today- 1.5-3.0" by sunset

Tonight- additional 5.0-8.0" snow overnight with blowing/drifting

Tuesday- additional 2.0-4.0"

Storm total: 8.0-14.0"

Wind Gusts: 20 mph – 45 mph (leading to blowing and drifting snow) Please continue to monitor weather forecasts, conditions could change/worsen

Please Remove Automobiles from Road Curbsides Wherever Possible Leaving automobiles parked along road curbsides will negatively impact plowing efforts (makes plowing take longer, clears less of the road, and leaves more snow in road following plowing).

## Please Do Not Travel Unnecessarily

Between Monday and Tuesday evening, the severe conditions will make travel **extremely dangerous**, leading to a high possibility of stranded automobiles that divert emergency personnel and plows.
