ROAD CLOSURE INFORMATION

1. CHIMNEY ROCK ROAD OVERNIGHT CLOSURES PLANNED

Chimney Rock Road between Route 22 Eastbound Local and Route 28 (Union Avenue) in Bridgewater will be closed to thru traffic overnight on Thursday, Friday and Monday – May 7, 8 and 11 – from 6 p.m. to 6 a.m.

This will allow the contractor to perform steel girder erection for the bridge widening over Interstate 287 and roadway widening construction on Chimney Rock Road between Route 22 Eastbound Local and Easy Street.

Chimney Rock Road will be closed at both approaches to the bridge; however, access to all of the businesses along the road on both sides of the bridge will be available at all times.

Temporary detour signage and a Bridgewater police traffic director will provide trafficcontrol assistance.

2. PROMENADE BOULEVARD, (CR 685) INCLUDING EAST MAIN STREET SIDEWALKS Safety improvements to traffic lanes and pedestrian sidewalks will be underway during the spring of 2015. Construction operations are to run from March to June 2015 with traffic maintained through the work zone areas on two lanes of the 4 lane roadway.

Work is to begin on March 9, 2015 on East Main Street across from TD Bank Ballpark for the construction of sidewalks. Later in March work will proceed onto Promenade Blvd. with construction work to the median islands and sidewalks. Daytime work hours are 7 am to 4 pm. Milling and paving of the roadway will occur in May utilizing over-night work hours of 9 pm to 6 am.

3. NORTH MOUNTAIN AVENUE

North Mountain Ave will be under construction beginning Monday March 9, 2015. There will be posted detours in effect and the road will remain open to emergency vehicles at all times.

4. MT HOREB ROAD CONSTRUCTION

Mount Horeb Road will be undergoing a milling and paving project during the overnight hours this week. The project covers areas in Bridgewater, Warren and Bernards Townships. The work is currently scheduled for Tuesday 6/9/15 and Wednesday 6/10/15 between the

hours of 2000 hours and 0600 hours each night. Officers from Bridgewater, Warren and Bernards Township will be directing traffic during the construction.

Emergency vehicles will have access during the entire project.

5. COUNTRY CLUB ROAD

Construction on Country Club Road between Garretson Road and Rolling Hills Road will begin on or around Wednesday, June 24, 2015 for sidewalk, curb, and drainage improvements, road base repairs, and resurfacing of the pavement. Through traffic will be detoured for the duration of construction. Access to homes fronting on Country Club Road within the work zone will be maintained but parking at alternate locations may be necessary for brief periods during the road base repairs and finish paving.
