Chairman Sweeney announced to the members of the public in attendance that the foregoing application for Quick Chek was withdrawn by the applicant.

The Board answered some questions from the public in attendance about how the application process works.

MEETING OPEN TO THE PUBLIC:

OTHER BOARD BUSINESS:

Board Attorney Vastola stated that he received a letter from the attorney for the applicant Presbyterian Church of Bound Brook Application# 25-11-ZB requesting an amendment to the resolution that was originally adopted on 11/24/15. Mr. Vastola read the changes as follows:

- 1. Paragraph 4 of the resolution states that the life estate portion of Lot 27 is to be devoted to cemetery use. The resolution is amended to provide that all of Lot 27 is to be devoted to cemetery use.
- 2. The second sentence of paragraph 4 states: "The area within the circle will have the potential for 950 cemetery plots or a columbaria". This sentence is eliminated and the following inserted in its place.

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"The applicant shall have the option of 208 regular grave sites or a combination of columbaria and gravesites within the circle".

- 3. No Developer's Agreement shall be required.
- 4. In all other respects the Resolution remain unchanged.

Motion by Mrs. Powers, second by Mr. Weideli, the resolution for the Presbyterian Church of Bound Brook Application# 25-11-ZB was amended as read on the following roll call vote:
