ROAD CLOSURE INFORMATION

- 1- Construction on Hunter Road will begin on or around Monday, September 11, 2017 for drainage improvements, road base repairs, and resurfacing of the pavement. Through traffic will be detoured during working hours and potentially overnight briefly. Access to homes fronting within the roadway improvement zone will be maintained but parking at alternate locations may be necessary for brief periods during the road base repairs.
- 2- Construction on Drum Hill Road will begin on or around Monday, October 2, 2017 for Handicap ramp and select sidewalk replacement, curb repairs, drainage improvements, road base repairs, and resurfacing of the pavement. The roadway will remain open for local traffic only with partial lane closures in effect. Access to homes fronting within the roadway improvement zone will be maintained but parking at alternate locations may be necessary for brief periods during the road base and curb repairs.
- 3- Construction for the BWT-2 Roadway Improvement project will commence on or around Wednesday, October 25, 2017. This project includes Donahue Road and Krams Trail. Improvements will include Handicap ramps, select sidewalk replacement, curb repairs, drainage improvements, road base repairs, and resurfacing of the pavement. The roadway will remain open to local traffic only with partial lane closures in effect. Access to homes within the roadway improvement zone will be maintained but parking at alternate locations may be necessary for brief periods during the road base and curb repairs.
- 4- Construction for the BWT-3 Roadway Improvement project will begin on or around Thursday, October 19, 2017. The roadways included within this project are Dow Road (Country Club Road to Madison Avenue) and Roosevelt Street East. Improvements include Handicap ramps, select sidewalk replacement, curb repairs, drainage improvements, road base repairs, and resurfacing of the pavement. A detour route will be provided for Dow Road whereas Roosevelt Street East will remain open to local traffic only with partial lane closures in effect. Access to homes within the roadway improvement zone will be maintained but parking at alternate locations may be necessary for brief periods during the road base and curb repairs.
- 5- Construction on Hauck Road will begin on Wednesday, October 18, 2017 for drainage improvements, road base repairs, and resurfacing of the pavement. Through traffic will be allowed during working hours with partial lane closures in effect. Access to homes within the roadway improvement zone will be maintained but parking at alternate locations may be necessary for brief periods during the road base repairs.
