ROAD CLOSURE INFORMATION

- 1- Construction for the Dogwood Drive Roadway Improvement project will commence on or around Friday, April 27, 2018 for drainage improvements, curb and road base repairs, and resurfacing of the pavement. Through traffic will be detoured during working hours and potentially overnight briefly. Access to homes fronting on Dogwood Drive will be maintained but parking at alternate locations may be necessary for brief periods during the road base and curb repairs.
- 2- Adamsville Road and Sunnyside Terrace will be under construction for three weeks starting April 16, 2018 and through traffic should plan alternate routes between 7:00AM & 5:00PM weekdays. Local traffic will have access, but they will experience delays due to lane closures and construction traffic.
 - UPDATE for Adamsville Road The milling operation is expected to occur on Tuesday, May 8 and the paving operation on Wednesday, May 9. The paving may be done "in echelon" which will require a moving area of full road closure as the road is paved full width with two paving machines side by side. Paving in this fashion provides a superior product by eliminating a seem.
- 3- Construction on Colonial Road will begin on Monday, December 4, 2017 for drainage improvements. The roadway milling and paving work will be performed in the spring of 2018. Through traffic will be allowed during working hours with partial lane closures in effect. Access to homes within the roadway work zone will be maintained.
- 4- Somerset County Bridge No. G0803 on Finderne Avenue (CR 633), located between Union Avenue (Rt. 28) and Foothill Road (near Rt. 22), will be under construction for the next 9 months. Starting Tuesday, February 20, 2018, Stage 1 Traffic Control will be implemented at the center portion of Finderne Avenue, to allow for the demolition and replacement of the center portion of the existing bridge. Through traffic northbound/southbound will utilize the right lanes in each direction; motorists should follow the posted signs throughout the construction zone. The duration of Stage 1 (center work zone) will be approximately 3 months. The County will provide updates and advance notice for the various staged traffic shifts during the course of this construction project.
