On Wednesday, March 6th, Mayor Hayes and staff toured the American Cyanamid Superfund site owned by Wyeth Holdings, LLC, to see firsthand the progress being made in protecting public safety and environmental restoration. Specifically, the Mayor toured the new groundwater treatment facility with Pfizer staff. Pfizer assumed responsibility for the site through its larger acquisition of Wyeth years ago. As a chemical engineer with an MBA, the Mayor appreciates the complexity and financial commitment in working through the process of cleaning up this 435-acre site.
