Parent Information Sheet for Summer Playgrounds Program 2018 - Retain for your records!

Welcome to Bridgewater Township Recreation Department! We encourage everyone to participate in our programs. We have a working relationship with the Somerset County Therapeutic Recreation Department (TR) allowing for recreation programs that can promote an active lifestyle that improves social, cognitive, emotional functioning and enhances participants' abilities. If your child has any special needs and may require a reasonable accommodation, please note appropriately on the following registration form six (6) weeks prior to the deadline date to allow for ample time to process the request and ensure proper accommodations!

Monday, July 9th - Friday, August 3rd, 2018

What is the Bridgewater Recreation Summer Playgrounds program? It is a program for all Bridgewater and Raritan resident boys and girls **entering** first (1) to eighth (8) grade. Site breakdown and fees are as follows:

<u>Van Holten School</u> Entering Grades 1, 2, 3 & $4 \sim 8:30$ am to 2:30pm \sim Bridgewater Resident Fee \$100; Raritan Resident Fee \$125.

<u>Bradley Gardens School</u> Entering Grades 4, 5, 6, 7 & 8 \sim 9:00am-3:00pm \sim Bridgewater Resident Fee \$80; Raritan Resident \$105

<u>Eisenhower School</u> Entering Grades 4, 5, 6, 7 & 8 ~ 9:00am-3:00pm ~ Bridgewater Resident Fee \$80; Raritan Resident \$105

<u>Hillside School</u> Entering Grades 4, 5, 6, 7 & 8 \sim 9:00am-3:00pm \sim Bridgewater Resident Fee \$80; Raritan Resident \$105

Registration received after 5pm on Monday, June 25, 2018 will result in a \$20 late fee! Note: All registration fees are non-refundable!

Every child must be registered. Even if your child attends one minute of one day or every minute of every day, they must be registered at the Bridgewater Recreation Department to be able to participate in this program. Registration *will not* be accepted at the playground sites nor will it be accepted without the appropriate registration fee. There is absolutely no switching of sites after the registration deadline. Registration is based on a first-come, first-served basis at the Bridgewater Recreation Department. Some sites do close out due to an overwhelming number of participants. **Please note that this program is ninety-nine percent held outside!**

For the safety and welfare of all participants the following breakdown will be in place for the 2018 Summer Playgrounds Program...

All 1st, 2nd, 3rd & some 4th graders (school year 2018–2019) will enjoy (4) fun-filled weeks at Van Holten School (Van Holten Road). All participants must be residents of Bridgewater or Raritan. The hours for this location will be 8:30am to 2:30pm. 1st, 2nd & 3rd graders will not be allowed at any other site.

The 4th to 8th grade program will be held at the following sites; Bradley Gardens School (Pine Street), Eisenhower School (Steeple Chase Lane) and Hillside School (Brown Road) for all Bridgewater and Raritan Resident boys and girls currently completing 3rd to 7th grade in the 2018-2019 school year. Children entering the 4th to 8th grades (2018-2019 school year and a Bridgewater or Raritan Resident) will enjoy (4) fun-filled weeks of playgrounds! Participants will be separated by grades pending registrations and/or playground site. There is absolutely no switching of Summer Playground Sites once the program has begun or if sites fill to capacity before the registration deadline. The hours for the 4th to 8th grade program sites will be 9:00am to 3:00pm.

Arrivals & Departures Each site opens at its designated time listed above, do not send your child early, counselors are not responsible for any children that arrive before playground hours of operation. All parents or authorized people are required to escort the child to the sign in/out table at the playground site. Please do not leave your child until he or she has been signed in. If someone other than the parent is picking up or dropping off, the counselors at the sign in/out tables must have written authorization including people's name. Identification will be required before a child is released. Please note: if you need to make any changes to your child's registration form/pickup information, you must do so in person at your child's site. No changes will be made over the phone. Each site closes at a designated time, please understand that by picking up your child after the closing time, a late fee of \$10.00 will be charged and must be paid before the child is permitted back into the program. Check made payable to "Bridgewater Township".

Inclement Weather policy

<u>Delayed Opening Information!</u> In the event of a day that the weather conditions are questionable in the morning all sites *might* have a delayed opening or close for the day. If a delayed opening is announced all sites will open at 10:00am! For inclement weather information visit <u>www.bridgewaternj.gov</u> or call the <u>Code-A-Phone at (908) 526-7107</u> for a recorded message in the morning before the start of the program or during the day for closings due to inclement weather. In the event of rain during the course of the day, those children allowed to leave on their own will be sent home. Participants who are not allowed to leave the park site on their own must have a way home. Parents, please have a plan to get your child in case of sudden inclement weather. Remember, it could be raining on one side of town but not the other! You may call the Recreation Department for an update.

<u>Trips</u> Information regarding possible trips will be available at each playground site the 1st week of camp. Trips are not mandatory and there may be additional fees to attend. All participants going on a trip **must take Recreation-provided transportation** to and from designated locations, NO EXCEPTIONS. **No refunds will be given for a trip unless Recreation has cancelled.**

<u>Clothing</u> Send your child to camp in comfortable clothes appropriate for the weather. No sandals or open toed shoes are allowed. If your child does not have appropriate shoes they will not be permitted to attend the program that day. Shorts, T-shirts and sneakers are acceptable. As we are outdoors all day, we advise all parents to sun screen their children before they arrive.

<u>Discipline Policy</u> Any discipline issues will be documented by a counselor in writing in a discipline report to be signed by the parent or guardian of the child. The Recreation Department reserves the right to review all discipline sheets and will make any necessary decisions on a case by case basis. If the child exhibits prolonged disruptive or unacceptable behavior, he or she will be dismissed from camp. Special events refunds are not given if a child is suspended from the program.

<u>Medications</u> Playground staff is not authorized to administer any type of oral medication to any playground participant (i.e. aspirin, cough medication...). If your child requires an Epi-Pen for an emergency situation, parents are required to complete an Authorization for Administration of Medication form from the Bridgewater Recreation Department. This form needs to be renewed annually. Please submit the Epi-Pen form along with the registrant's program registration form.

Emergency Procedures In the event of a medical emergency, the playground staff will respond according to the degree of injury. If the injury is minor (cut, scrape, bruise, etc.), the counselor on site will attend. If the injury is of a more serious nature (sprain, possible fracture, heat exhaustion), the head counselor will attend to your child and the parent/guardian will be notified immediately. If the parent/guardian is not accessible, the emergency medical number will be called. Accident reports are filled out within a 24-hour period. Depending on the nature of the injury, a doctor's note readmitting the child to camp may be required. Injuries may occur, please note that Bridgewater Township Recreation Department does not provide individual medical coverage for its participants. Each participant will be covered under his/her family's medical policy. It is recommended that families have insurance before the child participates.

Keeping Informed keeping us informed is very important to the success of our camp program. Parents must notify head counselors when information on your registration form has changed. This includes, but is not limited to, someone other than those listed on your child's registration form will be picking your child up, a child is not able to be picked up on time, an incident or change occurs in your child's life that alters his or her attitude, behavior, or causes emotional upset (i.e., divorce, loss of a pet, death in the family), your child has a contagious disease (i.e., head lice, pink eye, chicken pox). Parents will be contacted immediately if your child has received an injury which could require immediate medical attention; your child exhibits a medical condition which could be contagious or threatening to others in the program; your child is ill and unable to participate in daily activities. Parents will be notified at pick-up time if your child receives a minor injury that does not require the service of a professional in the medical field; your child complains of a non-emergency condition or symptom; your child exhibits unusual behavior.

<u>Food and Nutrition</u> Yes, camp gets very hot during July/August. We cannot emphasize enough the importance of providing proper food and drink for your children. In the event of a special lunch date organized by the counselors and a child requires a special diet; it is the parent's responsibility to provide lunch. **Please note** – many of our children have food allergies; please be mindful when packing lunches and/or snacks and explain the importance of clean-up and hygiene.

<u>Lunches and Snacks</u> Please send your child to camp with a lunch each day marked clearly with their name. Send a lunch that will not spoil, in a bag or small lunch box or cooler. The campers will not have access to a refrigerator or vending machines. Periodically, ice cream trucks may stop at the playgrounds; at this time your child may wish to purchase an ice cream and/or snacks.

<u>Money</u> Please limit the amount of money you send to camp with your child each day. Children are responsible for their own money, our staff is not able to hold your child's money. Be advised that there will be *no refunds* given for any special events that your camp site has planned for an additional on site fee (i.e., Pizza Day, Tie Dye day . . .) if your child is absent from camp on that day.

<u>Personal Items</u> Please label all toys, games, books, towels, or other items your child might bring to camp. Please put the child's full name on the article and our staff will make every attempt to return lost items to the rightful owners. The counselors, Recreation Department and Township assume no liability for the items brought from home. Any item which is lost or stolen is the responsibility of the owner. It is suggested that valuable items be left at home.

More information will be available at your child's Playground Site once the program begins. Keep in touch with your counselors!

How to register for our popular program? Complete the registration form (print legibly), choose the option on the registration form that is best for you! Please note; registrations will not be accepted at the playground sites! Also, only one registration form per participant. Registration is on a first-come, first-served basis at the Bridgewater Recreation Department; some sites do close out before the deadline due to overwhelming numbers of participants. Registration Deadline: Monday, June 25, 2018 at 5:00pm.

Three ways to register: (1) In-person at the Bridgewater Recreation Department Monday through Thursday from 9:00am to 5:00pm and Fridays 8:00am to 5:00pm. (2) Via Postal Service registration forms & payment can be mailed to Bridgewater Recreation Department 100 Commons Way – Bridgewater, NJ 08807. (3) Drop Slot – drop registration forms in the "REC" mail slot located on the Garretson Road side of the building/Employee Entrance (door to the left of the old main entrance when looking from the flag pole – it is flush with the building and not visible from the parking lot; go up the three steps and it is a slot marked 'Recreation'). You can drop off all registrations in this mailbox 24 hours a day/7 days a week.
