The Township of Bridgewater requires all of their volunteer coaches and assistants to have both the Rutgers Certification and a Criminal History Background Check in order to volunteer. In order to acquire these credentials through the Bridgewater Recreation Department, volunteers must be pre-approved by the Recreation Department and also attend any mandatory coaches and/or program meetings.



<u>Rutgers Youth Sports Safety Orientation & Training Workshop</u> – Mandatory for all volunteers of youth sports. This clinic meets the "Minimum Standards for Volunteer Coaches Safety Orientation and Training Skills Programs' (N.J.A.C. 5:52) and provides partial civil immunity to volunteer coaches as per the 'Little League Law' (2A:62A-6 et. seq.)" It is mandatory for all coaches and assistants participating in Township activities to become Rutgers certified. The workshop will be held at the Bridgewater Senior Citizen Center (455 Somerville Road) on the following dates:

If you are planning to attend a Rutgers Clinic outside of Bridgewater Township, pre-authorization from the Bridgewater Recreation Department is required.
