FALL RABIES CLINIC

The Bridgewater Township Health Department strongly urges all residents to maintain rabies vaccinations for their dogs and cats. Rabies in wildlife continues to be a public health concern in New Jersey and our community. The best defense against rabies is to assure that vaccinations are current for all domestic animals. Proof of current rabies vaccination is also necessary to license all dogs and cats.

The Bridgewater Township Health Department has scheduled a Fall Rabies Clinic for dogs and cats. The clinic will be held **Tuesday, November 12, 2018 at the Finderne Firehouse. The firehouse is located at 672 East Main Street in Bridgewater.**

Rabies vaccinations for dogs will be held between 6:00 PM - 7:00 PM.

Rabies vaccinations for cats will be held between 7:00 PM - 8:00 PM.

All dogs brought to the clinic must be securely leashed or in a carrier. All cats must be brought to the clinic in a secure box or carrier. All pets must be accompanied by an adult. Current license information at the time of the clinic is not necessary, but will serve to expedite the vaccination process. All rabies vaccinations at the clinic are provided free of charge.
