


# Clearing of Trail System

- After several storms, the existing trail that had been cut by DPW is overgrown with several large downed trees blocking access.
- DPW will perform basic upkeep on the trail system and clear any large obstructions.
- The trail includes a 2 mile loop around the property
- Timeline: January/February 2021

Condition Evaluation of Remaining Structures

 After demolition is complete, there will be 4 primary structures remaining

- Dining Hall
- Performing Arts Center
- Welcome Cabin
- Indoor Basketball Court

 Township Code Enforcement will undertake an evaluation of all remaining structures and evaluate the condition of each building.

## **Public Access for Passive Use**


- The ultimate goal for next year will be to allow public access to the site for passive use and allow residents to enjoy the property
- Administration/Municipal Services are discussing a location for a potential parking lot
- The grounds must be made safe before that occurs

#### Trail Connections

- The Camp Cromwell proposed trail system has the potential to connect to the Middle Brook Trail, Buttermilk Falls, Chimney Rock Park and Crim Fields
- A connection to the Middlebrook Trail could be achieved by making safe crossings from the property across Brookside Drive and Vosseller Ave.
