How can YOU prevent false fire alarms?

1. Keep your fire alarm & its system clean and maintained by a professional. On an annual basis (NFPA 72)
2. Notify your fire alarm monitoring company if you are testing or fixing then notify the County Communications Center & the Fire Safety Bureau of such testing.
3. Know how to cancel a false fire alarm, Follow up with the alarm company & the County Communications Center.
4. Have licensed professionals install your fire alarm proper with Construction permits obtained from Bridgewater Code Enforcement Division.
5. Treat your system with care.
