QUALIFICATIONS:

- Applicants must possess a valid license as a Plumbing Inspector of the appropriate level, High-Rise and Hazardous (HHS) issued by the New Jersey Department of Community Affairs.
- Sub-Code technical license is a plus
- Appointee will be required to possess a driver's license valid in New Jersey.
- Experience in performing plumbing inspections
- Ability to read and interpret plans, specifications, and engineering drawings.
- Excellent verbal and written communication skills
- Strong customer service skills and must be able work professionally with municipal officials, contractors and the general public to offer sound and accurate information in a customer based environment
- Strong computer skills
- Knowledge of the Bridgewater infrastructure is a plus
- Must be willing and able to work outdoors

SUPPLEMENTAL INFORMATION
