#### **CHIEFS REPORT:**

39 calls, 856 Man Hours - Report attached

- Monday, May 30<sup>th</sup> Bridgewater Township Memorial Day Parade
- Monday, June 6<sup>th</sup>, @ 6:30 p.m. Big Rig Rescue training hosted by Somerville FD.
- All Fire chiefs from the township have confirmed paying \$750.00 for the October training seminar.
- Continuing to work with PSE&G on emergency gate access on Sebring Avenue.
- Four members have completed RIC Awareness and Operations training at the training academy.
- Car 30B was taken to Bridgewater Chevy for a recall repair. Repair was made and car 30B is back in service.
- Requests a workshop to discuss the replacement plan for a vehicle.
- On May 23, 2022, Utility 30 was taken to Fullerton Ford for a recall repair. Repair was complete and back in service.
- Place a phone call to Tasc Fire Apparatus, Inc. regarding our failed hose, no returned call.
- I will have a list of hose needed at the next meeting.
- Contacted Approved Fire Protection to schedule the yearly fire extinguisher inspection for June.

- UL was contacted for aerial ladder inspection on Tower 30. Non-Destructive (NDT) will be performed on 6/21/22. A qualified driver must be present for the testing. The driver will be compensated \$100 for the day.
- Ground ladder and pump testing was completed on May 17, 2022, by Technical Fire Services, Inc. No written report or invoice was provided.
- On April 6, 2022, Fire station 30 responded to a gas leak on Rt. 22 involving PSE&G electric division who struck a gas line underground. The call started at 9:49 a.m. and didn't clear to almost 3:00 p.m. Several members responded and missed a day or work. I am looking for assistance to have our members reimbursed for their time according to FEMA pay guide that has been used in past incidents.
- As of April 30, 2022, we have responded to 131 emergency calls for service in 2022. Below is the breakdown of hours from 1/1/2022 4/30/2022:
  - o 1,349-man hours spent on emergency calls.
  - o 805-man hours spent on work details and meetings.
  - o 508-man hours spent on drills and training.
- A total of 2,662-man hours have been spent by the men and women of Finderne Fire Department in 120 days. This equates to 665.5-man hours a month or 155-man hours per week.
