Fall Leaf Bags

Fall leaf bags can be picked up at the Department of Public Works starting in **October** between 8-3PM, M-F until supplies run out. Please bring identification when picking up bags. Only leaves should be placed into the leaf bags. Grass clippings, brush, and other materials will NOT be picked up. The bags are picked up continuously on a rotating basis Monday-Friday throughout the Township between Nov 1 - Dec 31st, weather permitting.
