Budget Realities and Unfunded State and Federal Mandates

- Affordable Housing: Compliance with state mandates for affordable housing
 requirements places additional financial obligations on the Township. Recent new
 initiatives from Trenton place increasing burdens on municipalities throughout the state,
 and Bridgewater is not alone in our mandatory burdens. The 2024 budget accounts for
 these mandates by allocating resources to meet the stipulated criteria without
 compromising other essential services.
- **Stormwater:** New state and federal initiatives require that Bridgewater addresses stormwater runoff and related infrastructure a significant budget consideration. Funds

are allocated to enhance drainage systems and mitigate flooding risks, ensuring the town is better prepared for severe weather events.

• **Inflation:** Inflation has led to an increase in the standard operating costs for the municipality, affecting various budget areas such as healthcare, utilities, vehicle maintenance, and other routine expenses. The budget aims to address these rising costs by implementing efficient spending practices and ensuring that essential services are maintained without compromising quality.

Other Budget Highlights

- Master Plan: The budget includes funds for the implementation and adoption of the Master Plan, a comprehensive framework designed to guide the town's growth and development over the coming years. These funds will support strategic initiatives in town planning, zoning, and community development. This includes investments in physical improvements to the center's interior, such as updated furnishings and modernized activity spaces.
