### PRIMARY ELECTION

The Primary Election will take place on **Tuesday, June 10, 2025**, from 6:00 AM to 8:00 PM.

#### REGISTRATION DEADLINES FOR THE PRIMARY ELECTION

- Opt-Out of Vote by Mail: **April 4, 2025**
- Change Party Affiliation: **April 16, 2025**
- Register to Vote: **May 20, 2025**
- Apply by Mail for a Mail-In Ballot: **June 3, 2025**
- Apply in Person for a Mail-In Ballot: **June 9, 2025, by 3:00 PM**

### GENERAL ELECTION

The General Election will take place on **Tuesday, November 4, 2025**, from 6:00 AM to 8:00 PM.

#### REGISTRATION DEADLINES FOR THE GENERAL ELECTION

- Register to Vote: **October 14, 2025**
- Apply by Mail for a Mail-In Ballot: **October 28, 2025**
- Apply in Person for a Mail-In Ballot: **November 3, 2025, by 3:00 PM**

### VOTER REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS

To register to vote, you must meet the following criteria:

- Be a **U.S. citizen**
- Be at least **17 years old** (but cannot vote until you are 18)
- Be a **resident of Somerset County** for at least 30 days before the election

- Not be **serving a sentence of incarceration** as a result of a conviction of any indictable offense under the laws of New Jersey, another state, or the United States.

You must complete a **Voter Registration Application** and mail or deliver it to:

## DECLARING PARTY AFFILIATION

- **Change Party Affiliation:** Registered voters affiliated with a political party who wish to change their party affiliation must file a Political Party Affiliation Declaration Form 55 days before the Primary Election.
- **Unaffiliated Voters:** Unaffiliated voters may declare their party affiliation up to and including Primary Election Day.
- To declare or change your party affiliation, complete and submit the Political Party Affiliation Declaration Form to:

- Wednesday, **April 16, 2025** is the last day to declare/change party affiliation

## VOTE BY MAIL

- All active Democratic and Republican voters who have requested a mail-in ballot will receive a Vote by Mail ballot for the 2025 Primary Election.
- **Unaffiliated voters** will not automatically receive a mail-in ballot. However, they may declare their party affiliation to receive a mail-in ballot for the Primary Election.

The **County Clerk's office** will begin mailing ballots **45 days before the election**. If you do not receive your mail-in ballot, or need a replacement, contact the **Somerset County Clerk's Office** at **(908) 231-7013**.

#### MAIL-IN BALLOT RETURN OPTIONS:

- Mail your ballot through the United States Postal Service, ensure it is postmarked on or before Election Day
- Deliver directly to the **Board of Elections' Office** in Somerville by **8 pm on Election Day**
- Drop off at a designated **Somerset County Board of Elections' drop box** by **8:00 PM on Election Day**. Drop boxes are secure and monitored by video surveillance.

## VOTE IN PERSON – EARLY VOTING

## ELECTION BOARD WORKERS NEEDED

The Somerset County Board of Elections is seeking qualified district board workers to staff the polls during the 2025 election cycle.

### POLL WORKER REQUIREMENTS :

- Must be a **registered voter** of Somerset County.
- **High school students** (ages 16-17) may serve as poll workers with written permission from a parent/guardian and school representative.
- Workers must be assigned to a polling location in their registered County.
- The hours on Election Day are from 5:15 a.m. to 8:15 p.m.
- Interested parties should fill out and submit a [poll worker application](#) to [ElectionBd@co.somerset.nj.us](mailto:ElectionBd@co.somerset.nj.us) as soon as possible, and will be directed to an online training program they must complete before being assigned a polling location.
- You may also sign and return the application to Somerset County Board of Elections, PO Box 3000, Somerville, NJ 08876
  - If you are planning on working for the Republican Party, please send the form to the attention of Regina.
  - If you are planning on working for the Democratic Party or if you are Unaffiliated, please send the form to the attention of Robin.

### TRAINING

All poll workers are now required to attend a class every other year. A two-hour training class is required for new board workers. Failure to comply will reduce the Election Day compensation to \$50.00. Click here for [a brief summary](#) of the poll worker training.
